Baltimore, MD - The Painted Palette, a locally owned 'paint and sip' art studio located in historic Mt. Washington Village, will celebrate its third anniversary in September. The company was started in 2012 by two Baltimore born-and-raised best friends, and was conceived out of a love for art, music, and – of course – wine. It also blended the desire to open a small business in Baltimore that focused on customer service and providing a fun, entertaining experience.

“Brooke and I decided to start The Painted Palette in 2012 when we saw a similar concept on our travels in Chicago,” says co-owner Rebecca Hauser. “As a women-owned small business, it has been an extremely rewarding process to be embraced by the local community and to watch our business grow and evolve during the last three years.”

Since its opening, the studio has expanded its core product from painting on canvases to also include sessions on wood panels and wine bottles. The Painted Palette also offers family friendly classes at least twice a month (although you don't have to be 21 or older to attend during the week). And, unlike other "paint night" organizations, besides being locally owned and operated, The Painted Palette offers smaller class sizes and a BYOB (and snacks too) atmosphere. The owners also take pride in working with organizations and individuals to create customized, private party painting classes. Fundraisers are also available!

In addition, the studio has received media attention from ABC2 news anchor Jamie Costello, and a nod from Baltimore Magazine as part of its 2014 “Best of Baltimore” roster, just to name a few.

To celebrate the 3rd year anniversary milestone, all sessions at the Painted Palette studio will be just \$25 – a \$10 savings off the regular price during the month of September.

“We are so grateful and thankful for how our business has grown to date and we look forward to continuing our expansion both in painting offerings and community relations,” says Brooke Blumberg, co-owner.

The Painted Palette is located at 5708 Newbury Street in Mt. Washington Village.
